NOTES TO TABLE 1

If any quota remains from the summer fishery, it will be added equitably to the next fishery period for each side up to the maximum allocation. For 2017 the 16G Herring WG are proposing that of 10% of the total quota (with flexibility for annual adjustments) be allocated for the summer fishing period and that the North and South side fish against this allocation together.

- Options are still available for the 16G Working Group to amend the daily limits in respect of the effort on the Northside vs Southside specific fall fisheries to ensure effort does not exceed the resource available . To address effort control issues during the fall roe fishery off North Lake the following protocol is being proposed by the 16G Working Group: (Active vessel numbers from the DFO-DMP site will be reviewed on Sept 12th & Sept 19th if adjustments needed, then on Sept 24th the open fishery resumes per table above.).
 - September 10th start up at 15000 weekly limit, then if on the Sept 12th or Sept 19th review the Special Project will adopt the following adjustments:
 - <30 vessels on Northside = 15000 weekly limit
 - 30- 45 vessels on Northside = 12000 weekly limit
 - > 45 vessels on Northside = 10000 weekly limit
